USE OF COCKING SPORTS FIELD IN CONJUNCTION WITH BOOKINGS FOR COCKING VILLAGE HALL.

Cocking Village Sports Field is a public space for the village, and villagers have free access at all times. Exclusive access/use cannot be granted . Please remember this is also a children's play area . Appropriate risk assessment and insurance of property and persons must be provided by the hirer

Car Parking

- The car park is managed by the Cocking Village Hall Committee and Parish Council. and the gate is to be secured at all times and padlocked at the end of the hire period . Access codes will be granted on request by Cocking Village Hall Committee in connection with any Hire.
- Any vehicle damage/personal injury arising from use of the car park is at the owner's risk.

Vehicles

- Vehicles may NOT be driven on the field surface without prior permission from the Village Hall Management Committee/Cocking Parish Council

Tents, Gazebos and small Marquees

- May only be placed on the Sports Field at a location agreed with the Cocking Village Hall Management Committee., and with respect for neighbouring properties.

Music and other Noise creating activities

- The Village Hall is licenced for music to be played within the premises. Music may only be played outside the hall with prior permission from the Management Committee/Parish Council. No music is permitted after 11 pm and at all times noise must be kept at a reasonable level.

Fires, BBQ's, Hog roasts

- Fires may not be lit on the grass, and BBQs must be at least 3 metres away from the Village Hall building. All fires and BBQs must be fully extinguished at the end of use. All ash must be removed by the hirer.
- Enclosed hog roasts may be permitted on request, and must be situated at least 3 metres away from the Village Hall building. These may not be placed on the grass. A drip tray must be used to avoid fat staining on the paving or outside areas.

Organised Games and other activities

- Any organised games or activities must be conducted with respect for the neighbours and other field users, in terms of the space used and noise or nuisance created in the process. The Village Hall Committee /Parish Council reserve the right to prevent such activities if deemed to be causing a nuisance.

Litter

- Any litter generated by activities in the Sports Field must be collected and removed by the user.

Dog fouling

- Dog fouling on the field area is not permitted – users are responsible for clearing up after their animals.
